The Qualification

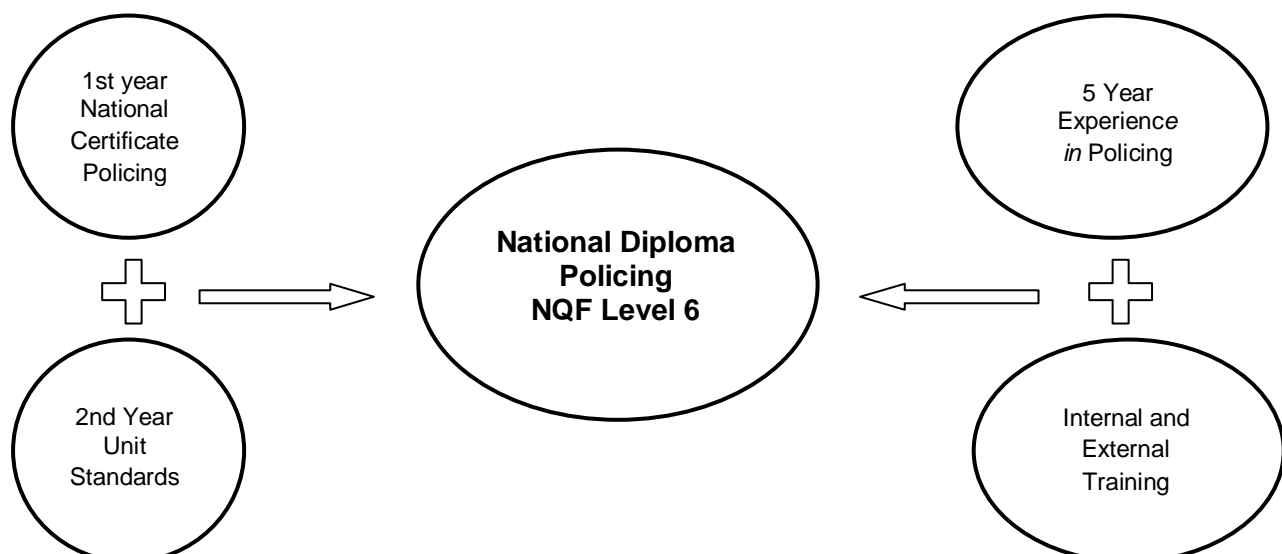
Duration

The National Certificate: Policing is a one year qualification with a total of 130 credits. The National Certificate Policing is structured in 6 modules spanning two semesters. Learners who have already attained the National Certificate Policing or relevant NQF 5 qualification have automatic access to the Diploma. (One year).

Accreditation

National Certificate: Policing is registered on the SAQA database at NQF Level 5. It is accredited by the Safety and Security Seta [SASSETA]. Thus upon successfully completing of this programme, you will receive a National Certificate: Policing NQF Level 5 from SASSETA.
