List of contents required by SAPS for Competence and Firearm application
Remember the more information you can give the SAPS the better
They want to see that you are serious about owning a firearm.

1. Particulars of applicant.

- **4 colour photos.**
- I.D. book and **3 copies.**
- Original Firearm license and **1 copy.**
- Training provider certificate and **2 copies.**
- R70.00 for **competence Application (saps 517)** per person **(Cash)**
- R70.00 for **renewal (saps 517e)** of existing license **(Cash)**
- R140.00 for a **new firearm license (saps 271) (Cash)**
- If employed make a copy of your pay slip/ letter of employment.
- If you are **not a S.A. citizen** / Supply proof of Permanent residence.
- If you can get a letter from a doctor to say you are a stable person. **(Great)**
- Competence and firearm Applications you get at the police station or www.magnum-sa.co.za

2. Particulars of spouse / Partner / Parents

- A letter from them to say they have no objection to you owing a firearm and that you are a stable person.
- A certified copy of their I.D book

3. Witness to take along to the police station

- **Take 2 people** to the SAPS if the application is a **renewal**- someone that lives with you and someone that does not. (E.g. Wife and friend)
- **Take 3 People** to the SAPS if the application is a **new firearm**. (E.g. Wife and two friends)

4. Experience / training / history of firearm handling

- How you grew up with the firearm- on farm /plot/ hunting / school etc.
- Did you have any Military / police / security experience / training etc.
- Letters or certificates of prior experience / Hunting or training.
- Club membership and testimonials

5. You need to motivate each firearm; this is structure on how to motivate

- Your full names and your employer name and your position at the company.
- Address where the firearms are being kept, do you rent or own the property, who else lives there.
- A list of the firearm/s and a description / special features/ history.
- If you can take photos of the firearm and the safe, great!

6. Description of the house

- Type of wall around your house/ electric fencing/ palisade /bob wire etc
- Do you have security gates and bars on the windows, exterior lights and dogs
- Do you have an alarm and is it connected to which company, attach invoice as proof

7. What is the need for the firearm

- You work late/ you carry cash with you (business owner), carry expensive equipment etc.
- You need the firearm to protect yourself and your family
- You live in a crime-infected area, mention the crime around you, and if you have been hijacked or robbed before mention the case numbers. **And lastly you must say that the firearm will be used as a last resort, since all the security measures have been put in place.**
